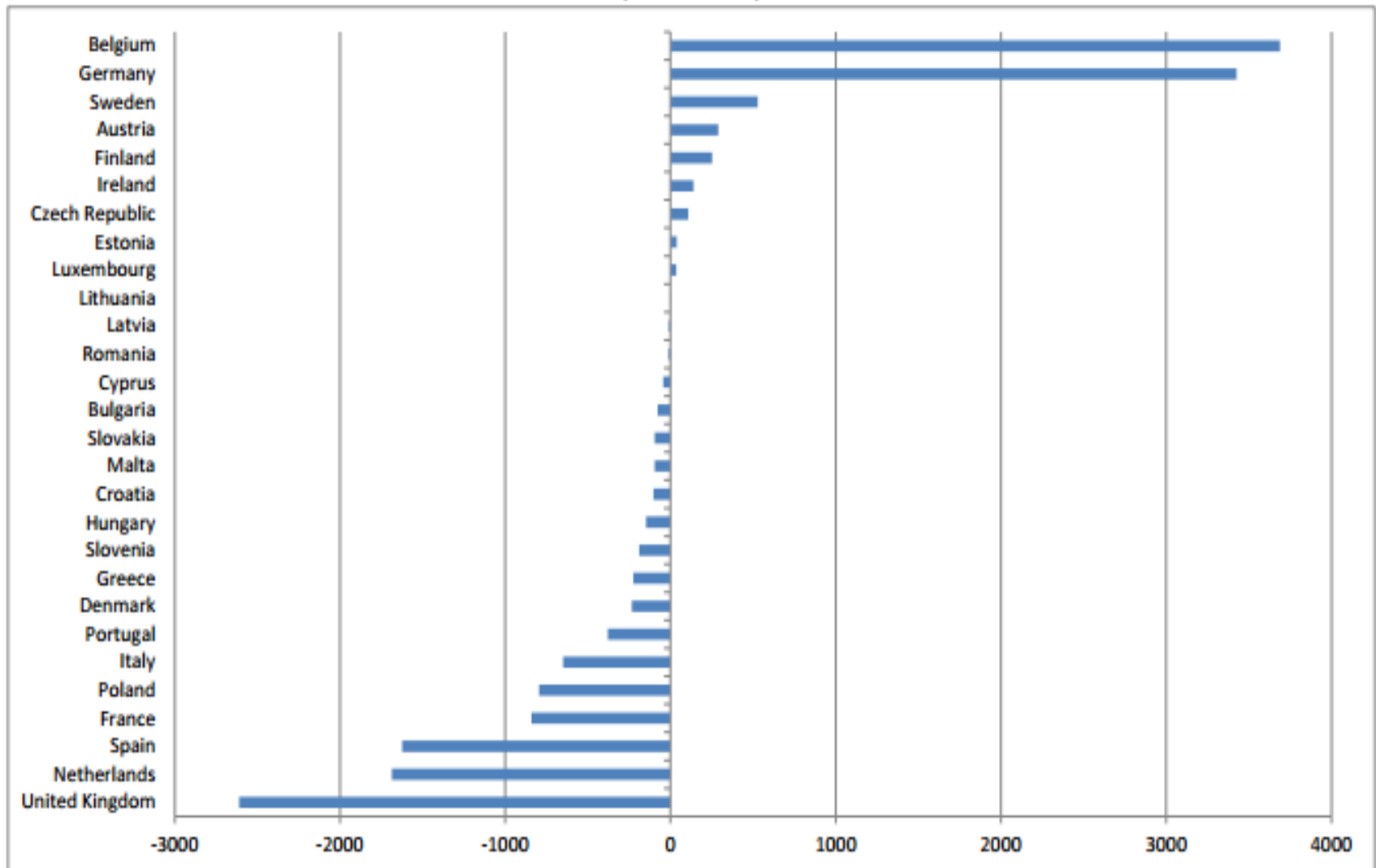
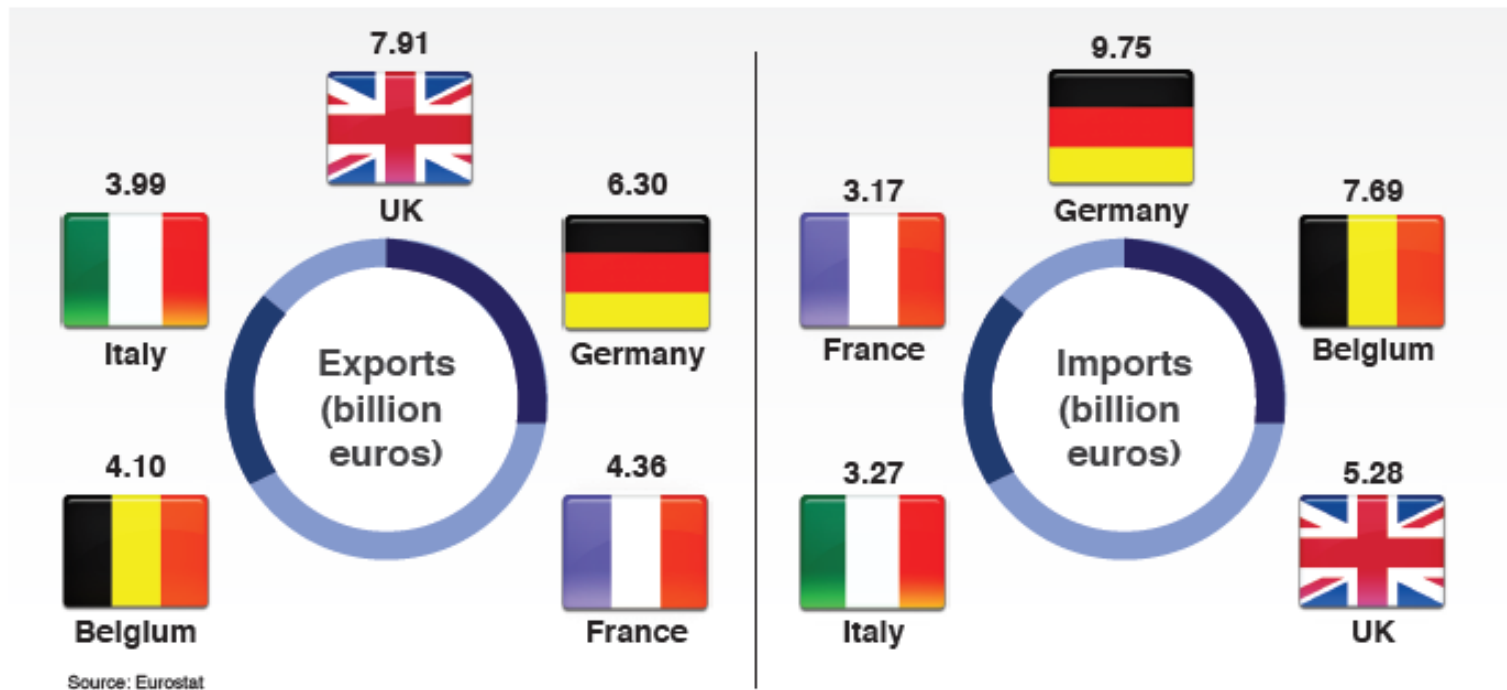


OPPORTUNITIES POST BREXIT– Perspective from India

 - ▶ EU remains major source of FDI and technology for us.
 - ▶ EU continue its lead role as a global standard setter.
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- ▶ Strongly urge the EU to restart India–EU Bilateral Trade and Investment Agreement (BTIA) negotiations.
 - ▶ Of course, we need to factor in BREXIT and recalibrate the deal.
 - ▶ India has a special relationship with the UK.
 - ▶ There are major opportunities, both with the EU and the UK and our focus should be on nurturing relationships on all sides.
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
